

Aerial Operations

Should you wish to operate any equipment in the air (unmanned drone), the following need to be met because of the venue's close proximity to Auckland Airport and the direct overhead flying zone.

REMOTELY PILOTED AIRCRAFT (RPA) / DRONES

- 1. The drone must be operated by a competent person.
- 2. The operator must keep a visual sight of the drone always when operating it.
- 3. The drone cannot be operated higher than 100 feet (or approximately 30m) or flown above cloud or in heavy fog.
- 4. When operating the drone outdoors, it can only be operated during daylight hours.
- 5. Authorisations must be requested through AirShare (<u>www.airshare.co.nz</u>) To request an authorisation you will need to register and log into AirShare. Log your flight using the "fly now" button.
- 6. Do not operate over dry flammable vegetation.
- 7. Provide a safety plan to the Venue with a hazard management plan.
- 8. Use the attached map to show where you intend to operate the RPA.
