BUILD YOUR OWN RAFT

Build Your Own Raft is the perfect half day team building and fun group activity that will test your group's ability to think on your feet, work together and assemble a raft within 60 minutes!

 An instructor to facilitate the challenge

TAMARIKI INFLATABLE KAYAKING

Minimum age 13 years old and above
 Briefing and understanding of environment required
 We recommend that you be physically fit, a strong swimmer and be very confident in the water.

Experience the white water environment and be your own guide on the Grade 1-2 Tamariki River. Go solo or there are tandem inflatable kayaks that offer great stability and control.

A higher level of water confidence is required as you won't have a guide with you on the water, however River Safety will be patrolling the edge of the river in case of an emergency.

What's included

Single or double inflatable kayak
 All the required safety equipment – life jackets, helmets and booties

All participants need to bring suitable swimwear like boardshorts and polyprop top, towel, and change of clothes. Hot showers are free to use, and lockers are available for hire. Participants are required to have a high level of water confidence. This is a non instructed programme.

EXTREME RAFTING

Extreme rafting on Grade 3-4 river
 Minimum age 13 years old and above
Activity requires a higher level of fitness. Participants will be required to demonstrate swimming ability

Crank up the challenge with your crew of 4 and conquer the River Rush. Manoeuvre a sports raft down the mighty rapids, surf and swim the river, and go down the Pump Waterfall --- twice! Guaranteed to make your adrenaline rush.

Advanced rafting on Grade 3-4 river
 Minimum age 13 years old and above

If you're after an adventurous team building activity, then River Rush rafting on our Grade 3-4 River is for you. This activity is sure to give your team the ultimate Wero Challenge and will encourage you to use team work to navigate your way downstream, led by our qualified raft guides. The activity ends with a big splash by rafting over the worlds highest man-made waterfall, the 4.5m Pump Waterfall!

Participants do not require any previous rafting experience, and all we ask is that they are comfortable around water.

FLAT WATER KAYAKING AND PADDLEBOARDING

Minimum age without parents on water is 8 years old
Children aged 5/6/7 years old must be accompanied by a parent on water

Explore our beautiful 9,000 sq metre man-made lake with a stand up paddle board or sit-on-top kayak as you follow a Treasure Map. Perfect for those just wanting to chill and relax under the clear blue sky!

Minimum age 13 years old and above.

Ride down the rapids of the Tamariki River in this exciting activity! These donuts are not your regular pool floaters but are for next-level, white water tubing to bump, twist and turn down our Grade 1-2 river.
